- 1- A 7 year old child reports with history of drooping of upper eye lids of both eyes present since birth,
  - a) How will you evaluate this patient?
  - b) How will you manage this patient?
- 2- A mother brings her 08 months old daughter with history of recurrent dirty discharge from both eyes for last 4 months. She is worried about the vision of her daughter
  - a) How will you assess the vision in this infant and what important visual parameters one would look in this age group?
  - b) What advice would you like to give to the mother about her discharge?
- 3- A 4<sup>th</sup> year medical student suddenly develop severe pain, redness , watering and photophobia in the left eye. Student is myopic by 0- 5.0D and a regular contact lens wearer,
  - a) What is the most probable diagnosis?
  - b) What diagnostic test you will like to do in this case.
  - c) Write down the treatment protocol.
- 4- A 13 year old boy is wearing glasses for the last 05 years with frequent change in refractive power. The vision in his right eye was poor even with glasses and now he has developed watering, severe photophobia and blurring of vision,
  - a) What is your most likely diagnosis
  - b) Enlist differential diagnosis.
  - c) What possible treatment is available?
- 5- A 60 year old otherwise healthy male underwent cataract surgery with vitreous loss at the time of surgery. He develops now sudden painless visual deterioration in the same eye totally obscuring his vision.
  - a) What is most likely diagnosis?
  - b) How will you confirm the diagnosis you have made for this patient.
  - c) What treatment options are available?
- 6- A tennis player got trauma to his left eye during his final match. He develops black eye immediately with gradual lid swelling and diplopia.
  - a) How will you proceed to reach at the diagnosis?
  - b) How will you manage this case?
- 7- A 50 year old lady is referred to eye OPD from medical outdoor for evaluation of exophthalmos and severe bilateral redness in the eyes. On examination her vision is impaired in her right eye along with relative afferent papillary defect
  - a) Give your diagnosis for this patient
  - b) Enlist all ocular signs of the disease supporting your diagnosis.
  - c) Write down the medical treatment.
- 8- A middle aged male gives history of frequent change of glasses for his distance and near vision for the past 06 months. He is not satisfied with his frequently changing numbers and wants your expert advise on it.
  - a) What is the possible reason for his frequent refractive change
  - b) What diagnostic test would you like to do to confirm it?
  - c) What treatment options are available?
- 9- A 70 years weak individual presented with recently developed epiphora with episodic attacks of irritation and foreign body sensation. Examination reveals inturning of left lower eyelid.
  - a. Classify the condition?
  - b. How will you manage the case?
